Chicago Trip Rules and Guidelines - March 26-29

- No alcohol/tobacco/drugs/school banned contraband allowed on the trip. If you break this rule, your parents will come and get you will be their responsibility at that point. You will also be subject to the Tri-Center School's consequences.
- Dress code: **Thursday** - comfortable travel clothes. **Friday** - nice school clothes. (nice jeans, polo's, button-up shirts, sweaters) **Saturday** (performance day) - dress clothes (khaki's, dress pants, dress shirts, dress shoes, dresses/skirts), students will be able to change into nice school clothes following the performance for the remainder of the day. **Saturday/Sunday** - nice school clothes.
- Money - you will be responsible for paying for several meals during the trip so make sure you plan accordingly. We will also be on the Magnificent Mile and be at Navy Pier so you will want some shopping money. Chicago can be more expensive than Omaha so plan accordingly!
- Be safe with your money! Men should carry wallets in your front pocket! Women should be careful with your purse/wallets! Chicago is a major city so be aware and proactive to make sure you don't get pickpocketed or lose your money!
- You must stay in groups of 4 people! Pay attention to each other and be responsible for each other! We are a family and everyone needs to work together to stay safe!
- Pay attention to directions from your director's, chaperones, and tour guide. It is imperative that you know when, where, and what time you're supposed to be places.
- There will be a security guard in the hotel at night so you will be expected to stay in your room after lights out and be very quiet in the hotel.
- There will be no girls in guy's hotel rooms and no guys in girl's hotel rooms. No exceptions! You can congregate in the halls quietly and the hotel lobby.
