

## Tri-Center Orlando Music Trip Information

**Dates:** March 21st – March 27th

**Trip Numbers:** 58 people

**Weather:** Currently between 60 and 80 degrees most days

**Clothing:** Students are expected to dress comfortably for the short bus trip down. When visiting sites or at the amusement park, students will be expected to dress in school appropriate clothing. We will be watching the weather to let students know what is expected prior to and while we are there. We are representing Tri-Center so students are expected to show pride in how they dress! If students wear something that Mrs./Mr. Baker, another chaperone, or myself feels is inappropriate, they will be asked to change clothes. **In this time of year, the weather can fluctuate greatly so students need to be ready for cooler, warmer, and even rainy weather!**

We will be performing at Universal Studios on Sunday, March 26<sup>th</sup>. Students will have a uniform they are expected to wear. **That uniform will consist of – a grey Tri-Center polo (students will need to purchase for \$12.00), khaki pants (light brown color), and black shoes. Every student will need to wear this uniform as per Universal studio's performance rules. Students will be able to change clothes after our performance.**

**Behavior:** We have great kids at Tri-Center, and our expectations for student behavior on the trip will be very high! **Absolutely no members of the opposite sex in each other's rooms! There are plenty of public spaces for students to hang out in at the hotel. Students are expected to follow directions from both staff and chaperones!**
